



New specialty liver biopsy test codes in U.S. and Canada.

We made it easier to request a test, and get complete and accurate results.

On April 1, 2023, the following service was added to the Anatomic Pathology test menu:

Test code	Test name	Turnaround time
HISTOLIV1	Liver Biopsy with Staining Panel	3–5 days (Monday–Friday)
HISTOLIV2	Liver Biopsy with Staining Panel and 1 Site/Lesion	3–5 days (Monday–Friday)
HISTOLIV3	Liver Biopsy with Staining Panel and 2 Sites/Lesions	3–5 days (Monday–Friday)
HISTOLIV4	Liver Biopsy with Staining Panel and 3 Sites/Lesions	3–5 days (Monday–Friday)

All liver specimens submitted with this code automatically include copper, trichrome, iron, and reticulin stains that are processed concurrently with the liver biopsy submission and reported out with the liver biopsy results. For more details, please visit idexx.com/liverbiopsy.

How this helps you and your practice:

- + Liver Staining Panel (copper, trichrome, iron, and reticulin) automatically included upfront when ordering this test code
- + All liver biopsy submission specimen types accepted
- + Standardized report formatting for liver biopsy results and stains
- + Multi-site codes available to order when submitting additional non-liver sites along with the liver biopsy (up to 3 sites)
- + Liver staining panel with the 4 liver stains processed along with the liver submission will give you the answers you need faster with no need to add on the Liver Staining Panel after the biopsy results are final
- + Consistent liver stains with every submission
- + Consultation with the reading pathologist when you have additional questions
- + Neoplastic conditions are typically inappropriate for staining

Note: If the reading pathologist deems it medically appropriate for 1–2 liver stains to be added to liver biopsy specimens ordered with routine or complex biopsy test codes, the reading pathologist will request these at no charge and a final addendum of results will follow within 3–5 days (Monday–Friday).

If 3 or more liver stains are recommended, the reading pathologist will notify customers to contact IDEXX to suggest adding on the Liver Staining Panel Add-on to Biopsy (test code 6981).
